The ALA South Central Group are pleased to invite you to its Summer Farm Visit at Meon Springs, Whitewool Farm, East Meon, Petersfield, Hampshire GU32 1HW on **Wednesday, 6 June 2018**

Whitewool Farm is a traditional mixed dairy and arable farm that has been in the Butler family since 1930. They run a herd of 430 dairy cows supplying milk exclusively to Sainsbury's. They grow all the forage crops for the herd plus wheat, barley and oilseed rape.

Like many farms, they have diversified over the years branching out into fly fishing, glamping holidays, storage and providing a venue and training for business development.

- 4.45 Back on tractor and trailer via the fishery before returning to Long Barn
- 5.00 Chance to 'have a go' under instruction at clay shooting and fly fishing. If attendees already fish then they are free to fish into the evening.
