The Masterclass will consider the issues that arise in the negotiation and drafting of options and leases or similar documents for the extraction of minerals, mineral ownership issues, dealing with statutory undertakers including the Mining Code and an interactive workshop session based on a relevant scenario. The emphasis will be on the legal issues in a practical and commercial context.

The Masterclass will be led by Richard Lashmore who is a Partner and Team Leader of the Mines & Minerals team at Knights Plc.

Richard has a wide experience of the quarrying and waste industry acting for operators, mineral owners and public authorities, with a particular emphasis on dealing with larger and complex transactions and technical issues in a commercial context.

Richard also deals with property development projects both in their own right and in their interrelation with minerals projects and mineral rights. He has published articles on his specialist area and is a regular speaker at conferences. He has also provided training for the Land Registry on mineral ownership issues.

Richard specialises in mining, quarrying and waste agreements, leases, licences disposals and acquisitions, mineral ownership and rights including manorial rights; specialist advice on the mining code and compulsory acquisition of rights; post quarrying use and development and involvement in dispute resolution involving minerals and waste issues.

He regularly advises on the minerals and waste assets in the context of corporate and business sales and acquisitions.
