Falldon has been owned the Bridgeman family since 1946. Mark took over the management of the farm and estate in 2006. It is 2,400 acres consisting of the main in-hand farm, 3 AHA farm tenancies, woodland, biomass, residential lettings, holiday let business (www.bruntoncottages.co.uk) and housing development. The in-hand farm at Brunton, is a mixed organic holding of 1,400 acres. There is also a large HLS agreement and B&B pig rearing operation.

Mark is currently Deputy President of the CLA and sits on the board of two London listed investment trusts as well as two charities. Prior to returning to Northumberland he worked for Schrodgers as a fund manager for 19 years.
